	<b>Cantor 2</b> prays first line <b>Side 2</b> joins in <b>Side 2 &amp; Side 1</b> alternate strophes	Canticle Glory to... As it Was...

	<b>Cantor 2</b> prays word or phrase, pauses <b>All join to complete</b>	Antiphon 2
	<b>Cantor 1</b> prays word or phrase, pauses <b>All join to complete</b>	Antiphon 3
	<b>Cantor 1</b> prays first line <b>Side 1</b> joins in <b>Side 1 &amp; Side 2</b> alternate strophes	Second Psalm Glory to... As it Was...
	<b>Presider</b>	Psalm Prayer, if applicable
	<b>Cantor 1</b> prays word or phrase, pauses <b>All join to complete</b>	Antiphon 3
	<b>Reader</b>	reading <i>Pause for silent reflection</i>
	<b>Reader</b>	Responsory 1
	<b>All</b>	Responsory 1
	<b>Reader</b>	Responsory 2 (first half)
	<b>All</b>	Responsory 2 (second half)
	<b>Reader</b>	Glory to the Father, and to the Son, and to the Holy Spirit.

<i>Stand</i>	<b>Presider</b> prays word or phrase, pauses <b>All join to complete</b>	Antiphon for Canticle of Zechariah
	<b>Cantor 1</b> prays first line <b>Side 1</b> Joins in	Blessed be the Lord, the God of Israel; He has come to his people and set them free.
	<b>Side 2</b>	He has raised up for us a mighty savior, Born of the house of his servant David.
	<b>Side 1</b>	Through his holy prophets he promised of old that he would save us from our enemies, from the hands of all who hate us.
	<b>Side 2</b>	He promised to show mercy to our fathers And to remember his holy covenant.
	<b>Side 1</b>	This was the oath he swore to our father Abraham: To set us free from the hands of our enemies, Free to worship him without fear, Holy and righteous in his sight All the days of our life.
	<b>Side 2</b>	You, my child shall be called the prophet of the Most High; For you will go before the Lord to prepare his way, To give his people knowledge of salvation By the forgiveness of their sins.
	<b>Side 1</b>	In the tender compassion of our God The dawn from on high shall break up on us, To shine on those who dwell in darkness and the shadow of death, And to guide our feet into the way of peace.
	<b>Side 2</b>	Glory to the Father, and to the Son, and to the Holy Spirit.
	<b>Side 1</b>	As it was in the beginning is now and will be forever. Amen
	<b>Cantor 1</b> prays word or phrase, pauses <b>All join to complete</b>	Antiphon for Canticle of Zechariah
	<b>Presider</b>	Opening prayer for intercessions
	<b>All</b>	Prayer in italics
	<b>Reader</b>	Each petition – first half
	<b>All</b>	Each petition – second half (other <b>general</b> intercessions may be added)
	<b>All</b>	Repeat prayer in italics
	<b>Presider</b> starts <b>All join</b>	Our Father...
	<b>Presider</b>	Closing Prayer
	<b>All</b>	Amen
	<b>Presider</b> <i>(if no ordained present)</i>	May the Lord bless us, protect us from all evil and bring us to everlasting life.
	<b>All</b>	Amen
